On the morning of 7 July 2005, Colin Morley was on board a westbound Circle Line tube train. At 08.49, shortly after the train had left Edgware Road Underground Station in the direction of Paddington Underground Station, an explosion occurred when a bomb was detonated by a terrorist in the second carriage of the train. Colin Morley was in the same carriage and was killed by the explosion.
