1. Name of the deceased

Jennifer Vanda Ann NICHOLSON

On the morning of 7 July 2005, Jennifer Nicholson was on board a westbound Circle Line tube train. At 08.49, shortly after the train had left Edgware Road Underground Station in the direction of Paddington Underground Station, an explosion occurred when a bomb was detonated by a terrorist in the second carriage of the train. Jennifer Nicholson was in the same carriage. She was blown out of the train and killed by the explosion. Her body was subsequently found on the tracks next to where the fifth carriage of the train had

come to rest.
