

Coroner's Inquests into the London Bombings of 7 July 2005

INQUISITION
An inquisition taken from our Sovereign Lady the Queen
At the Royal Courts of Justice
in the District of Inner West London
Opened on 20 July 2005
And, upon adjournment, continuing from 11 October 2010 to 6 May 2011
Before me, Rt Hon Lady Justice Hallett sitting as Assistant Deputy Coroner for Inner West London
Touching upon the death of Benedetta CIACCIA
The following matters are found

On the morning of 7 July 2005, Benedetta Ciaccia was on board an eastbound Circle Line tube train. At 08.49, as the train approached Aldgate Underground Station from the direction of Liverpool Street Underground Station, an explosion occurred when a bomb was detonated by a terrorist in the second carriage of the train. Benedetta Ciaccia was in

the same carriage and was killed by the explosion.
